Our Approach

Using an emotional-empathic approach, which assumes that all people regardless of their origin have the same basic needs, students learn to develop an empathic relationship with themselves and others, while acquiring a critical distance from emotionalising rhetoric.



By the help of our materials, young people learn to distinguish between constructive strategies for fulfilling their own basic needs and destructive ones in order to find solutions that serve the common good.

On this basis, different teaching modules and materials on the topic of democracy and human rights are offered, for which accompanying short videos are available.


Furthermore, a board game with a digital extension is being developed for use in class.
